LOUDENBECK'S SIGNATURES VALIDATED

Amy Loudenbeck first in 45th District to submit nomination papers

CLINTON, WI – (July 2, 2010) Amy Loudenbeck, Republican Candidate for Wisconsin's 45th Assembly District received confirmation from the Wisconsin Government Accountability Board (GAB) that 262 signatures on the Nomination Papers for Partisan Office she submitted on June 30, 2010 have been validated.

A check of the GAB website shows that Loudenbeck is the first of five candidates to submit completed nomination papers. Loudenbeck personally collected all of the signatures she submitted and says that she, "thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to share my goals and values with residents of the 45th Assembly District while circulating my nomination papers for ballot access." In addition to collecting signatures from neighbors, friends, family and local business owners, Loudenbeck attended Beloit Farmer's Market, the Taste of Clinton and the Shopiere 4th of July celebration.

With approximately 10 weeks to go before the Partisan Primary Elections on September 14, Loudenbeck says she can feel the excitement building for her campaign. "When I am out in the District talking to residents there is real hope that new leadership can bring prosperity back to the District and the state of Wisconsin. I want to represent the 45th District in Madison and use my experience and broad based knowledge of the district to solve problems and create solutions."

Loudenbeck worked at the Greater Beloit Chamber of Commerce from January 2003 to April 2010 interacting with a wide range of businesses, institutions and non-profit organizations in the district. After graduating from UW-Madison in 1991 with degrees in political science and international relations, she spent several years in Madison working for private companies that interacted with various levels of state government. Loudenbeck's career path led her into the field of environmental and engineering services, with an emphasis on regulatory and project management. She is presently self-employed as a landlord and regulatory compliance consultant and also serves as a Clinton Town Board Supervisor.
