AMY LOUDENBECK INTENDS TO FILE FOR 45TH DISTRICT

Long-time Wisconsin resident tosses hat into Republican ring

Beloit, WI – (April 28, 2010) Amy Loudenbeck of Clinton is announcing her intent to file as a Republican Candidate for the 45th Assembly District. “I understand the district, I know the political process and I value the benefits of teamwork and collaboration. I am ready to represent the 45th District in state government,” said Loudenbeck.

Loudenbeck, who recently left her position of Vice President for the Greater Beloit Chamber of Commerce where she worked for seven years, has interacted with a wide range of businesses, institutions and non-profit organizations in the district. A UW-Madison 1991 graduate with degrees in political science and international relations, she spent several years in Madison working for private companies that interacted with various levels of state government. Loudenbeck and her husband Matt, a Firefighter/Paramedic, live in the Town of Clinton where they enjoy working on their hobby farm and connecting with their rural counterparts.

Loudenbeck sees the diversity of the district as a great asset, and welcomes the challenge of representing the district and serving as an advocate for its residents in Madison. “I look forward to interacting with constituents in ways that are meaningful and comfortable for them. If there is no common ground on which to connect, people feel that they aren’t part of the political process, said Loudenbeck.

“Good government means building on those relationships and seeking common sense solutions. I can do that, which is why I want to represent the 45th Assembly District.”
